STEPPING STONE PROJECT LIST:

- gloves
- (1) 60 lb bag of Quikrete Mortar Mix (we bought ours at Lowes)
- (1) gallon of water
- large mixing bucket or wheelbarrow
- shovel or hoe to mix the mortar
- (roughly 6-8) various molds
- vegetable oil to coat the inside of the molds before adding mortar
- hand shovel to scoop the mix into the molds
- glass / stone / metal pieces

PROJECT STEPS:

- 1. Watch the short video if you like to see before doing.
- 2. Make a template of your molds and layout your design or simply do it freestyle. You have <u>roughly</u> an hour to play with it (maybe more).
- **3.** Add the water, then the mortar mix to your bucket or wheelbarrow and mix thoroughly with the shovel. It will be like a thick mud.
- 4. Coat your molds with vegetable oil.
- **5.** Scoop the mix into your molds, packing it well, lifting it and dropping it to remove air bubbles. Then, smooth the surface.
- **6.** This is a good time to quickly hose the mortar out/off of your container and tools.
- **7.** Place your glass / stone / metal pieces onto the surface of the stone, pushing them hallway into the mortar.
- **8.** After 2-3 days, remove your stones from the molds and clean them with a scrub brush and water.
- **9.** Put them where the sun will hit them and admire the beauty. =)
